	§61-8A-3. Exemptions from criminal liability.							

1 The criminal provisions of section two of this article do not apply to:

2 (a) A bona fide school, in the presentation of local or state approved curriculum, <u>except as</u>

#### 3 <u>otherwise provided for in §61-8A-6 of this code;</u>

4 (b) A public library, or museum, which is displaying or distributing any obscene matter to a
5 minor only when the minor was accompanied by his or her parent, <u>except as otherwise provided</u>
6 for in §61-8A-6 of this code;

7 (c) A licensed medical or mental health care provider, or judicial or law-enforcement officer,
8 during the course of medical, psychiatric, or psychological treatment or judicial or law-enforcement
9 activities;

(d) A person who did not know or have reason to know, and could not reasonably have
learned, that the person to whom the obscene matter was distributed or displayed was a minor and
who took reasonable measures to ascertain the identity and age of the minor, <u>except as otherwise</u>
provided for in §61-8A-6 of this code;

(e) A person who routinely distributes obscene matter by the use of telephone, computer
network or the Internet and who distributes such matter to any minor under the age of eighteen
years after the person has taken reasonable measures to prevent access by minors to the
obscene matter; or

1	(a) Definitions. – The following definitions shall apply for purposes of this section:									
2	(1) "Adult-oriented business" means an adult arcade, an adult bookstore or video store, an									
3	adult cabaret, an adult live entertainment establishment, an adult motion picture theater, an adult									
4	theater, a massage establishment that offers adult services, an escort agency, a nude model									
5	studio, or a drag performance; and									
6	(2) "Drag performance" means a performance:									
7	(A) In which one or more performers has a gender identity that is different from the									
8	performer's gender assigned at birth using clothing, makeup, or other accessories that are									
9	traditionally worn by members of and are meant to exaggerate the gender identity of the									
10	performer's opposite sex;									
11	(B) Sings, lip-synchs, dances, or otherwise performs before an audience of at least two									
12	persons for entertainment, whether performed for payment or not; and									
13	(C) That is intended to appeal to the prurient interest.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit drag shows from being performed in front of

minors and to prohibit drags shows in schools and libraries.
