- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §24-2-17a, relating to requiring that utility providers instigate text
- 3 communications concerning utility outages.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION.

§24-2-17a. Notification of utility outage. 1 (a) In addition to the expectations of §24-2-17 of this code, all public, private, and investor-2 owned utilities shall provide text notifications to customers when there is an outage either in 3 progress or expected. This text shall contain the following information: 4 (1) That the service has been interrupted; and 5 (2) The estimated length of time, measured in 30-minute increments, that the service will 6 be interrupted; and 7 (3) The areas affected by the outage using city, county, and state lines.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that utility providers instigate text communications concerning utility outages.

(b) This expectation shall become effective on July 1, 2024.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.

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
