- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
 designated §16-67-1, relating to requiring that public restrooms provide diaper changing
- 3 stations in both male and female restrooms if these stations are provided at all.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

	ARTICLE	67.	DIAPER	C	HANGING	STATIONS.
	<u>§16-67-1.</u>	Diaper	changing	station	location	requirements.
1	(a) Beginning January 1, 2025, all new business and charity locations open to the public					
2	with male and female restrooms that choose to provide a diaper changing station in the restroom					
3	for one gender must provide a changing station for the bathroom of both genders.					
4	(b) Nothing in this article shall be construed to read that a diaper changing station is					
5	required to be provided in any public restroom.					

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require that public restrooms provide diaper changing stations in both male and female restrooms if these stations are provided at all.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
