FISCAL NOTE

- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
  designated §11-14C-49, clarifying that the tax imposed on fuel purchased at marinas and
  boat docks in this state be directed to the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources Law
  Enforcement Division.
  - Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 14C. FUEL TAX. MOTOR EXCISE §11-14C-49. West Virginia Division of Natural Resources Law Enforcement Division to from tax on marina and receive proceeds boat dock fuel. All tax proceeds that are collected from fuel purchased at marinas and boat docks in this state shall be directed to the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources Law Enforcement
