A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
designated §46A-9-1 and §46A-9-2, all relating to requiring all retail businesses with a
physical location in this state to accept cash for charges up to \$100, and providing for
enforcement by the Attorney General, private causes of action.
