- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 centralized prescription processing.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Pharmacy.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2023, authorized under the authority of §30-5-7 of this code, modified by the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on September 26, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy (Board of Pharmacy rules
- 5 for centralized prescription processing, 15 CSR 14), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to centralized prescription processing.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
