1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the West Virginia Real Estate Commission to promulgate a legislative rule
 3 relating to requirements for real estate courses, course providers, and instructors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. West Virginia Real Estate Commission.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 28, 2023, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-40-8 of this code, modified by the West Virginia Real Estate Commission to meet
 3 the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register
 4 on September 27, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Real Estate Commission (requirements for
 5 real estate courses, course providers, and instructors, [174 CSR 03](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Real Estate Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to requirements for real estate courses, course providers, and instructors.
