- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
 designated §18-34-1, relating to the display of the official motto of the United States in
- 3 public elementary and secondary schools and in institutions of higher education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 34. DISPLAY OF NATIONAL MOTTO.

<u>§18-34-1. Display of the national motto in schools and state institutions of higher</u> education.

- 1 (a) A public elementary or secondary school or a state institution of higher education must
- 2 display in a conspicuous place in each classroom of the school or institution a durable poster or
- 3 <u>framed copy of the United States national motto, "In God We Trust", if the poster or framed copy</u>
- 4 meets the requirements of subsection (b) of this section and is:
- 5 (1) Donated for display at the school or institution; or
- 6 (2) Purchased from private donations and made available to the school or institution.
- 7 (b) A poster or framed copy of the national motto described in subsection (a) of this
- 8 section:
- 9 (1) Must contain a representation of the United States flag centered under the national
- 10 motto and a representation of the state flag; and
- 11 (2) May not depict any words, images, or other information other than the representations
- 12 listed in subdivision (1) of this subsection.
- 13 (c) A public elementary or secondary school and an institution of higher education may
- 14 accept and use private donations for the purposes of subsection (a) of this section.
