#### ARTICLE 10. FEES FOR REGISTRATION, LICENSING, ETC.

§17A-10-3c. Additional registration fees for alternative fuel vehicles.

- (a) The annual registration fee for a vehicle fueled with hydrogen or natural gas is \$200.
- (b) The annual registration fee for a vehicle operating on a combination of electricity and petrochemical fuels is \$100. Beginning July 1, 2024, the \$100 registration paid for vehicles operating on a combination of electricity and petrochemical fuels shall be refunded each year.
  - (c) The annual registration fee for a vehicle operating exclusively on electricity is \$200.
  - (d) The fees imposed by this section are in addition to any other fee set forth in this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a rebate of \$100 for owners of hybrid vehicles.
