- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 authorizing the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency, and Correction to
- 3 promulgate a legislative rule relating to sexual assault forensic examinations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO

PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES. §64-6-1. Committee Governor's on Crime, Delinquency, and Correction. The legislative rule filed in the State Register on September 8, 2023, authorized under the 1 2 authority of §15-9B-4 of this code, modified by the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency, 3 and Correction to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 9, 2023, relating to the Governor's Committee on Crime, 4 5 Delinguency, and Correction (sexual assault forensic examinations, 149 CSR 11), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency, and Correction to promulgate a legislative rule relating to sexual assault forensic examinations.
