## Senate Bill 398

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
designated §62-18-20, relating to creating the crimes of sexual extortion and aggravated
sexual extortion; defining terms; establishing elements of the crimes of sexual extortion
and aggravated sexual extortion; and establishing criminal penalties.
