- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §9-5-34, relating to correlating the Medicaid personal needs allowance with the
- 3 state poverty index.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:_

ARTICLE 5. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

§9-5-34. Medicaid needs allowance to be tied to state poverty index.

- 1 (a) Legislative findings. The Legislature finds that for the purpose of providing dignity for
- 2 <u>our elderly citizens, the Medicaid personal needs allowance should be directly correlated with the</u>
- 3 state poverty index. By tying the personal needs allowance to the state poverty index, senior
- 4 <u>citizens would be entitled to money for their personal needs, such as clothing, denture supplies,</u>
- 5 and other necessities.
- 6 (b) *Enactment*. The Medicaid personal needs allowance shall be tied to the state poverty
- 7 index.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to correlate the Medical personal needs allowance with the state poverty index.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
