- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the West Virginia Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- income tax credits for property taxes paid.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-7-1. West Virginia Tax Department.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2023, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §11-13MM-6 of this code, relating to the West Virginia Tax Department (income tax
- 3 credits for property taxes paid, 110 CSR 21H), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to income tax credits for property taxes paid.
