1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-2-1 et seq. of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, 2 relating to authorizing certain agencies of the Department of Administration to promulgate 3 legislative rules; authorizing the rules as filed and as modified by the Legislative Rule-4 Making Review Committee; authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a 5 legislative rule relating to the administration of records management and preservation; 6 authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a legislative rule relating to 7 retention and disposal scheduling; authorizing the Department of Administration to 8 promulgate a legislative rule relating to the management of records maintained by the 9 Records Center; authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a legislative 10 rule relating to exemptions from management services provided by the Fleet Management 11 Division; authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a legislative rule 12 relating to financial services reporting; authorizing the Information Services and 13 Communications Division to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the plan of operation; 14 authorizing the Information Services and Communications Division to promulgate a 15 legislative rule relating to telecommunications payments made by state spending units; 16 authorizing the Office of Technology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the plan of 17 operation; authorizing the Office of Technology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to 18 telecommunications payments made by state spending units; authorizing Public Defender 19 Services to promulgate a rule relating to the payment of fees and reimbursement of 20 expenses of court-appointed attorneys.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-2-1. Department of Administration.

(a) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on March 27, 2024, authorized under the
 authority of §5A-8-8 of this code, relating to the Department of Administration (general
 administration of records management and preservation, 148 CSR 12), is authorized.
