1 AN ACT to amend and reenact §64-2-1 *et seq.* of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
2 relating to authorizing certain agencies of the Department of Administration to promulgate
3 legislative rules; authorizing the rules as filed and as modified by the Legislative Rule-
4 Making Review Committee; authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a
5 legislative rule relating to the administration of records management and preservation;
6 authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
7 retention and disposal scheduling; authorizing the Department of Administration to
8 promulgate a legislative rule relating to the management of records maintained by the
9 Records Center; authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a legislative
10 rule relating to exemptions from management services provided by the Fleet Management
11 Division; authorizing the Department of Administration to promulgate a legislative rule
12 relating to financial services reporting; authorizing the Information Services and
13 Communications Division to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the plan of operation;
14 authorizing the Information Services and Communications Division to promulgate a
15 legislative rule relating to telecommunications payments made by state spending units;
16 authorizing the Office of Technology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the plan of
17 operation; authorizing the Office of Technology to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
18 telecommunications payments made by state spending units; authorizing Public Defender
19 Services to promulgate a rule relating to the payment of fees and reimbursement of
20 expenses of court-appointed attorneys.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-2-1. Department of Administration.

1 (a) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on March 27, 2024, authorized under the
2 authority of §5A-8-8 of this code, relating to the Department of Administration (general
3 administration of records management and preservation, 148 CSR 12), is authorized.

4 (b) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on March 27, 2024, authorized under the
5 authority of §5A-8-8 of this code, relating to the Department of Administration (retention and
6 disposal scheduling, 148 CSR 13), is authorized.

7 (c) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on March 27, 2024, authorized under the
8 authority of §5A-8-8 of this code, relating to the Department of Administration (management of
9 records maintained by the Records Center, 148 CSR 14), is authorized.

10 (d) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on April 30, 2024, authorized under the
11 authority of §5A-12-9 of this code, relating to the Department of Administration (exemptions from
12 management services provided by the Fleet Management Division, 148 CSR 23), is authorized.

13 (e) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on March 11, 2024, authorized under the
14 authority of §5A-2B-2 of this code, relating to the Department of Administration (financial services
15 reporting, 148 CSR 24), is authorized.

§64-2-2. Information Services and Communications Division.

1 (a) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on November 12, 2024, authorized under
2 the authority of §5A-7-2 of this code, relating to the Information Services and Communications
3 Division (plan of operation, 161 CSR 01), is authorized.

4 (b) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on November 12, 2024, authorized under
5 the authority of §5A-7-4 of this code, relating to the Information Services and Communications
6 Divisions (telecommunications payments made by state spending units, 161 CSR 02), is
7 authorized.

§64-2-3. Office of Technology.

1 (a) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 29, 2024, authorized under
2 the authority of §5A-6-4 of this code, modified by the Office of Technology to meet the objections
3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October
4 11, 2024, relating to the Office of Technology (plan of operation, 163 CSR 04), is authorized.

5 (b) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 29, 2024, authorized under
6 the authority of §5A-6-4 of this code, modified by the Office of Technology to meet the objections
7 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October
8 11, 2024, relating to the Office of Technology (telecommunications payments made by state
9 spending units, 163 CSR 05), is authorized.

§64-2-4. Public Defender Services.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 19, 2024, authorized under the
2 authority of §29-21-5 of this code, relating to the Public Defender Services (payment of fees and
3 reimbursement of expenses of court-appointed attorneys, 89 CSR 01), is authorized.
