1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5A-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Department of Human Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
3 to the Recovery Residence Certification and Accreditation Program.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5A. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5A-1. Department of Human Services.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on September 13, 2024, authorized under the  
2 authority of §16-59-2 of this code, modified by the Department of Human Services to meet the  
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 November 26, 2024, relating to the Department of Human Services (Recovery Residence  
5 Certification and Accreditation Program, [69 CSR 15](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Human Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Recovery Residence Certification and Accreditation Program.
