(a) "Candy" means the same as it is defined in section §11-15B-2.

(b) "Soft drinks" means the same as it is defined in §11-15B-2.

(c) The Secretary of Department of Human Services shall request a waiver from the United States Department of Agriculture to exclude candy and soft drinks from the definition of eligible foods under 7 C.F.R. 271.2. If such waiver is granted, then the Secretary shall prohibit the purchase of candy and soft drinks with benefits provided through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. If no such waiver is granted, then the cabinet Secretary shall request such a
