- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §17A-2-8 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to eliminating satellite DMV offices and restoring their functions to private organizations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

§17A-2-8. Commissioner of motor vehicles -- Office.

- 1 (a) The commissioner shall maintain an office in one of the State Capitol buildings. ~~and in~~
2 ~~such other places in the state as he may deem necessary properly to carry out the powers and~~
3 ~~duties vested in the department~~ The commissioner shall keep his or her ~~offices~~ office open at all
4 reasonable times for the transaction of public business.

- 5 (b) Beginning July 1, 2025, the commissioner may maintain only one office, which shall
6 confirm with subsection (a) of this section, and the duties previously performed by satellite offices
7 shall be performed by private organizations, such as the American Automobile Association (AAA).

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to eliminate satellite DMV offices.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law
and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
