- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
2 designated §30-3-21, relating to providing that patients undergoing medical procedures
3 may refuse to have such procedures observed by residents and medical students at the
4 hospital.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. WEST VIRGINIA MEDICAL PRACTICE ACT.

§30-3-21. Patient right to refuse observation by residents and medical students.

- 1 (A) - Patients may refuse residents and medical students from observing or performing
2 medical care on them. Each hospital shall implement a policy to ensure that patients are informed
3 of their right to refuse such observations.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to allow for patients to refuse to have their procedures observed by residents of the hospital or medical students.
