A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new article,
designated §5B-2P-1, §5B-2P-2, §5B-2P-3, §5B-2P-4, §5B-2P-5, and §5B-2P-6, relating
to creating an Office of Entrepreneurship within the Office of Economic Development.

	§5B-2P-4. Reporting.			
1	On or before November 1 of each year beginning two years after the creation of the Office			
2	of Entrepreneurship, and annually thereafter, the Office of Entrepreneurship shall submit to the			
3	Legislative Commission a report that includes, without limitation:			
4	(a) The number and total dollar amount of state contracts awarded to businesses that have			
5	been in operation for not more than five years, including, without limitation, a breakdown by			
6	demographic segments and geographical areas throughout the state;			
7	(b) The percentage of the number of state contracts awarded to businesses that have been			
8	in operation for not more than five years compared to the total number of contracts awarded;			
9	(c) The number of businesses owned by women, minorities, or veterans that have been in			
10	operation for not more than five years and have been awarded a state contract;			
11	(d) The percentage of the total dollar amount of state contracts awarded to businesses that			
12	have been in operation for not more than five years compared to the total dollar amount of			
13	contracts awarded;			
14	(e) The types of businesses awarded a state contract;			
15	(f) Recommendations on improving access to state contracts for businesses that have			
16	been in operation for not more than five years, including, without limitation, those businesses in			
17	statistically underrepresented demographic segments and geographic areas of West Virginia;			
18	(g) Recommendations on improving overall entrepreneurship in this state including,			
19	without limitation, identifying regional challenges to entrepreneurship; and			
20	(h) Any additional information considered necessary by the Office of Economic			
21	Development to provide an accurate depiction of the condition of entrepreneurship in West			
22	<u>Virginia.</u>			

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§5B-2P-5. Encouragement of application for state contracts.

1 The Office of Economic Development shall encourage five percent of the total number of

2 state contracts to be awarded to businesses that have been in operation for not more than five

- 3 years and whose principal place of business is in this state.
 - §5B-2P-6. Confidentiality.

1 All records, files, and communications of the Office of Entrepreneurship made or received

2 pursuant to this article are confidential and not a public record.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish an Office of Entrepreneurship within the Office of Economic Development.
