- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
2 designated §21-3A-10, relating to requiring an opioid antagonist be included in workplace
3 first-aid kits.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: _

ARTICLE 3A OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ACT.

§21-3A-10. Ensuring access to naloxone or opioid antagonist in the workplace.

- 1 The Commissioner or his or her agent shall, before December 1, 2027, require and ensure
2 that first aid materials in a workplace include naloxone hydrochloride or another opioid antagonist
3 approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration to reverse opioid overdose and
4 instructions for using the opioid antagonist.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require an opioid antagonist be included in workplace first-aid kits.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
