### **House Bill 3088**

- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,  
2 designated §33-17-9a, relating to establishing a minimum coverage amount of \$2,000 for a  
3 claim by a fire department for services provided in response to an event on insured  
4 property.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE            17.            FIRE            AND            MARINE            INSURANCE.**

**§33-17-9a. Minimum coverage for fire department response to event.**

- 1 All insurers providing fire insurance on real property in West Virginia shall be liable to a fire  
2 department that responds to an event on the real property requiring its services. All insurers shall  
3 include in their fire insurance policies a minimum coverage amount of \$2,000 for each occurrence.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to increase insurance coverage to a minimum amount of \$2000 that may be recovered by a fire department responding to fire call at an insured property.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
