A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
designated §16-5C-2, relating to nursing home registry information; providing legislative
findings; and requiring the inclusion of the names of medical directors of nursing homes on
an online site for public information.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5C. NURSING HOMES.

§16-5C-2. Registry of nursing home medical directors.

- 1 (a) The Legislature finds that:
- 2 (1) The Office of Health Facility Licensure and Certification runs an online Health Care
- 3 Facility Lookup page which provides the public with general information for all health care facilities,
- 4 including nursing homes, operating within the state of West Virginia;
- 5 (2) The Health Care Facility Lookup page is provided to the public for easy access to
- 6 general information on health care facilities and provides search parameters of facility type, facility
- 7 name, and county;
- 8 (3) The contact information provided includes the name of the facility, address, and
- 9 telephone number; and
- 10 (4) During a pandemic or large scale emergency it would be beneficial to the citizens of
- 11 West Virginia to have access to contact information for nursing home medical directors.
- 12 (b) The Department of Health shall include the name of each medical director for each
- 13 <u>nursing home on the Health Care Facility Lookup page.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide the citizens of West Virginia with the names of medical directors of nursing homes on the online site maintained by OHFLAC.
