A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section
designated §18-9F-10a, relating to allowing county boards to create standardized school
safety mapping data; setting forth requirements for mapping data; setting forth the
dissemination and cost parameters of data.

- 23 (b) The school safety mapping data set forth in subsection (a) shall be provided to the state
- 24 board of education, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, and local first
- 25 response agencies including police, fire, emergency medical services (EMS), and any other local
- 26 <u>entities the school's crisis response planning team determines should be consulted in accordance</u>
- 27 with this article. The data shall be provided at no cost beyond the initial cost of production and
- 28 <u>shall be made available to such entities permanently.</u>
