1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §4-2A-5a, relating to drug testing of legislators.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2A. COMPENSATION FOR AND EXPENSES OF MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE.

§4-2A-5a. Drug testing of legislators.

- 1 (a) The Legislature finds and declares that members of the Legislature, as public figures,
- 2 have a reduced expectation of privacy and that the job responsibilities of legislators greatly impact
- 3 public safety. As a result, establishing a requirement for members of the Legislature to be drug free
- 4 <u>is a reasonable government function.</u>
- 5 (b) Notwithstanding any provisions of this code to the contrary, no member of the
- 6 Legislature may receive any compensation or expense reimbursement pursuant to this article until
- 7 he or she successfully passes a drug test for all known illegal drugs and any legal drugs for which
- 8 he or she does not have a prescription. The test shall be conducted annually by December 31.
- 9 Failure to pass or take a drug test pursuant to this section precludes that legislator from receiving
- 10 <u>any compensation or expense reimbursement for any legislative session or activity in which he or</u>
- 11 she would otherwise be authorized to receive compensation or reimbursement under this article.
- 12 Each legislator shall pay the cost of his or her drug test.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require legislators to annually pass a drug test to receive any compensation or expense reimbursement.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.

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
