1	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new section,
2	designated §18-5-15h, relating to the creation of the West Virginia Homeschool Student
3	Athletics Participation Act; providing for a short title; providing for a purpose; setting forth
4	definitions; providing for implementation of the section; providing for an effective date; and
5	providing for severability.

18 (1) Homeschool students who are participants of a homeschool athletic organization shall

19	be permitted to participate in regular-season interscholastic athletic contests against WVSSAC
20	member schools, provided that:
21	(A) The homeschool athletic organization with guidelines applicable to health, safety, and
22	eligibility requirements are similar to those required of WVSSAC member schools.
23	(B) The homeschool team agrees to abide by WVSSAC rules and policies concerning
24	game conduct, officiating, and scheduling.
25	(C) Any homeschool team participating must provide proof of insurance coverage similar
26	to WVSSAC member schools.
27	(2) Homeschool organizations and teams participating under this section shall:
28	(A) Not be included in any official WVSSAC rankings, points systems, standings, or
29	statistical records.
30	(B) Not be eligible for WVSSAC postseason competitions, including but not limited to
31	sectionals, regionals, and state championships.
32	(C) Not affect the official record, win-loss tally, or statistical standings of WVSSAC member
33	schools, though results of contests may be recorded separately for historical purposes.
34	(3) A WVSSAC member school may voluntarily choose whether to schedule games
35	against a homeschool organization or team without penalty or mandatory participation
36	requirements.
37	(e) Implementation and oversight
38	(1) The WVSSAC shall oversee the implementation of this section and provide guidance to
39	member schools on how to incorporate homeschool team participation in a manner consistent with
40	WVSSAC policies.
41	(2) The WVSSAC shall ensure that all homeschool organizations wishing to participate
42	meet the basic eligibility criteria outlined in this section.
43	(3) Any disputes arising from the application of this section shall be reviewed by a
44	WVSSAC-designated committee, with final decisions being subject to appeal to the West Virginia

- 46 (f) Effective date. This article shall take effect on 30 days following its passage and
- 47 <u>approval by the Governor.</u>
- 48 (g) Severability If any provision of this section is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a
- 49 <u>court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the section shall remain in full force and effect.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide an opportunity for homeschool students to engage in interscholastic athletics while maintaining the integrity of WVSSAC rankings and postseason competitions.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
