1 A BILL expiring funds to the surplus balance in the State Fund, General Revenue, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, in the amount of \$1,192,452 from the Attorney General -2 3 Consumer Protection Recovery Fund, fund 1509, fiscal year 2025, organization 1500, and 4 making a supplementary appropriation of public moneys out of the Treasury from the 5 balance of moneys remaining as a surplus balance in the State Fund, General Revenue, to 6 the Department of Health – Central Office, fund 0407, fiscal year 2025, organization 0506, 7 by supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 8 2025.

WHEREAS, The Legislature finds that the account balance in the Attorney General –
Consumer Protection Recovery Fund, fund 1509, fiscal year 2025, organization 1500, exceeds
that which is necessary for the purposes for which the account was established; and

4 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature 5 on February 12, 2025, containing a statement of the State Fund, General Revenue, setting forth 6 therein the cash balance as of July 1, 2024, and further included the estimate of revenue for the 7 fiscal year 2025, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular and surplus 8 appropriations for the fiscal year 2025, and further included recommended supplemental 9 appropriations from the balance of the State Fund, General Revenue: and 10 WHEREAS, It appears from the Governor's Statement of the State Fund, General 11 Revenue, and this legislation, there now remains a surplus balance in the Treasury which is 12 available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the balance of the funds available for expenditure in the fiscal year ending June 30,
2025, Attorney General – Consumer Protection Recovery Fund, fund 1509, fiscal year 2025,
organization 1500, be decreased by expiring the amount of \$1,192,452 to the surplus balance of
the State Fund, General Revenue, to be available for appropriation during the fiscal year 2025.
