increasing the penalty for voluntary manslaughter.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Voluntary manslaughter shall be punished by a definite term of imprisonment in the						
penitentiary which is not less than three five nor more than fifteen 25 years. A person imprisoned						

pursuant to the provisions of this section is not eligible for parole prior to having served a minimum

of three five years of his or her sentence or the minimum period required by the provisions of §62-

5 12-13, whichever is greater.
