- designated §61-6-26, relating to DNA collection; defining terms; providing for penalties;
- 3 and providing for enforcement.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

	<u>§61-6-26.</u>	Collection	of	DNA	for	felony	convicts.
1	(a) Definitions:						
2	(1) "DNA" means deoxyribonucleic acid.						
3	(2) "CODIS" means the Combined DNA Index System.						
4	(b) Any individual convicted of and sentenced for a felony crime shall provide authorities						
5	with a DNA sample.						
6	(c) The DNA collected from each person convicted of a felony shall be run against						
7	evidence of other open cases and entered into CODIS.						
8	(d) Any person who refuses to provide a DNA sample shall be guilty of a misdemeanor						
9	and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$100.						
10	(e) Thi	s section shall b	e enforced by	/ all law enfo	orcement o	fficers within th	eir respective
11	jurisdictions.						

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to collect DNA from those convicted of crimes to assist in solving other open criminal cases.
