- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §17A-10-3c of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
2 relating to providing a rebate of \$100 for the registration of hybrid vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10. FEES FOR REGISTRATION, LICENSING, ETC.

§17A-10-3c. Additional registration fees for alternative fuel vehicles.

- 1 (a) The annual registration fee for a vehicle fueled with hydrogen or natural gas is \$200.
2 (b) The annual registration fee for a vehicle operating on a combination of electricity and
3 petrochemical fuels is \$100. Beginning July 1, 2025, the \$100 registration paid for vehicles
4 operating on a combination of electricity and petrochemical fuels shall be refunded each year.
5 (c) The annual registration fee for a vehicle operating exclusively on electricity is \$200.
6 (d) The fees imposed by this section are in addition to any other fee set forth in this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a rebate of \$100 for owners of hybrid vehicles.
