## Senate Bill 3

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §31-15A-17c of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, 2 relating to permissible expenditures by the Water Development Authority from the 3 Infrastructure Fund; modifying the upper limit of funds which may be transferred to sub 4 account; raising the cap on total project costs for certain facilities for use of Critical Needs 5 and Failing Systems Sub Account funding; and allowing the authority to grant 6 infrastructure grant money from the Critical Needs and Failing Systems Sub Account to 7 certain projects for the upgrading of a water facility or wastewater facility to reduce 8 maintenance costs, operations costs, or waterline leakages.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 15A. WEST VIRGINIA INFRASTRUCTURE AND JOBS DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL.

**§31-15A-17c. Critical Needs and Failing Systems Sub Account.** Notwithstanding any provision of this article to the contrary:

(a) The Water Development Authority shall establish a separate and segregated sub
account in the Infrastructure Fund designated the Critical Needs and Failing Systems Sub
Account into which the council may instruct the Water Development Authority to transfer from the
uncommitted loan balances on June 30 each year, up to \$12 million \$14 million.

6 (b) The council shall direct the Water Development Authority to make loans or grants from
7 the Critical Needs and Failing Systems Sub Account when the council determines that a project
8 will address a critical immediate need by:

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The continuation of water or wastewater services;

10 (2) Addressing water facility or wastewater facility failure due to the age of the facility or
11 facilities; <del>or</del>

(3) Providing extensions to a water facility or wastewater facility that will add customers
 with a total project cost of less than \$2 million \$3 million: *Provided*, That a person or governmental

- 15 10 percent of the total project cost; or
- 16 (4) Upgrading a water facility or wastewater facility to reduce the maintenance costs,
- 17 operations costs, or waterline leakages with a total project cost of less than \$300,000.
- 18 (c) Grant limitations and allocations contained in <u>§31-15A-10(b)</u> and <u>§31-15A-10(c)</u> of this
- 19 code do not apply to grants made from the Critical Needs and Failing Systems Sub Account.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to the modify the upper limit of funds which may be transferred to sub account; raise the cap on total project costs for certain facilities for use of Critical Needs and Failing Systems Sub Account funding; and allow the authority to grant infrastructure grant money from the Critical Needs and Failing Systems Sub Account to certain projects for the upgrading of a water facility or wastewater facility to reduce maintenance costs, operations costs, or waterline leakages.
