- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5A-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to authorizing the Department of Human Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating  
3 to the pilot program for drug screening of applicants for cash assistance.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5A. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5A-1. Department of Human Services.**

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on October 22, 2024, authorized under the  
2 authority of §9-3-6 of this code, relating to the Department of Human Services (pilot program for  
3 drug screening of applicants for cash assistance, [78 CSR 26](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Human Services to promulgate a legislative rule relating to pilot program for drug screening of applicants for cash assistance.
