- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5B-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to authorizing the Office of Inspector General to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
3 Behavioral Health Centers Licensure.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 5B. AUTHORIZATION FOR THE OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL TO
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-5B-1. Office of Inspector General.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 30, 2024, authorized under the
2 authority of §27-9-1 of this code, modified by the Office of Inspector General to meet the objections
3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November
4 26, 2024, relating to the Office of Inspector General (Behavioral Health Centers Licensure, [71](#)
5 [CSR 25](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Inspector General to promulgate
a legislative rule relating to Behavioral Health Centers Licensure.
