- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 authorizing the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to alternative
3 resolution of tax disputes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE
LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-7-1. State Tax Department.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 30, 2024, authorized under the
2 authority of §11-10-23 of this code, modified by the State Tax Department to meet the objections of
3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 9,
4 2024, relating to the State Tax Department (alternative resolution of tax disputes, [110 CSR 10G](#)),
5 is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to alternative resolution of tax disputes.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
