## Senate Bill 352

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the
- 3 exchange of information pursuant to written agreement.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### **ARTICLE 7. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO PROMULGATE**

#### LEGISLATIVE

RULES.

- §64-7-1. State Tax Department.
- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on March 11, 2024, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §11-10-5 of this code, relating to the State Tax Department (exchange of information
- 3 pursuant to written agreement, <u>110 CSR 50C</u>), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Tax Department to promulgate a legislative rule relating to exchange of information pursuant to written agreement.
