- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Department of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to select
- 3 plant-based derivatives and select plant-based derivative products.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Department of Agriculture.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 15, 2024, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §19-12E-12 of this code, modified by the Department of Agriculture to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 December 3, 2024, relating to the Department of Agriculture (select plant-based derivatives and
- 5 select plant-based derivative products, 61 CSR 30), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Agriculture to promulgate a legislative rule relating to select plant-based derivatives and select plant-based derivative products.
