### **Senate Bill 378**

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule  
3 relating to the schedule of fines.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.**

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 20, 2024, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-1-8 of this code, modified by the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to meet the  
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 October 8, 2024, relating to the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists (schedule of fines, [3 CSR](#)  
5 [07](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to promulgate a legislative rule relating to schedule of fines.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
