- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 consideration of prior criminal convictions in initial licensure determinations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on October 18, 2024, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-1-24 of this code, relating to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners (consideration of
- 3 prior criminal convictions in initial licensure determinations, 4 CSR 08), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to consideration of prior criminal convictions in initial licensure determinations.
