### **Senate Bill 383**

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule  
3 relating to funeral director, embalmer, apprentice, courtesy card holders, and funeral  
4 establishment requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Funeral Service Examiners.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 29, 2024, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-6-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to meet the  
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
4 November 22, 2024, relating to the Board of Funeral Service Examiners (funeral director,  
5 embalmer, apprentice, courtesy card holders, and funeral establishment requirements, [6 CSR 01](#)),  
6 is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Funeral Service Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to funeral director, embalmer, apprentice, courtesy card holders, and funeral establishment requirements.
