- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to waiver of initial
- 3 licensing fees for certain initial licensure applicants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on April 1, 2024, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, relating to the Board of Medicine (waiver of initial licensing fees
- 3 for certain initial licensure applicants, <u>11 CSR 13</u>), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to waiver of initial licensing fees for certain initial licensure applicants.
