- 2 authorizing the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to a

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO

PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on November 15, 2023, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, relating to the Board of Osteopathic Medicine (waiver of initial
- 3 licensing fees for certain initial licensure applicants, 24 CSR 08), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to waiver of initial licensing fees for certain initial licensure applicants.
