- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Uniform
- 3 Controlled Substances Act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 29, 2024, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §60A-3-301 of this code, modified by the Board of Pharmacy to meet the objections of
- 3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 16,
- 4 2024, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (Uniform Controlled Substances Act, 15 CSR 02), is
- 5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Uniform Controlled Substances Act.
