- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- authorizing the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the
- 3 application of waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Pharmacy.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 24, 2024, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, relating to the Board of Pharmacy (application of waiver of initial
- 3 licensing fees for certain individuals, 15 CSR 18), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Pharmacy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the application of waiver of initial licensing fees for certain individuals.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
