- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- authorizing the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to promulgate a
- 3 legislative rule relating to requirements for licensure and certification.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 30, 2024, authorized under the authority of §30-38-9 of this code, modified by the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
- 4 refiled in the State Register on October 7, 2024, relating to the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing
- 5 and Certification Board (requirements for licensure and certification, 190 CSR 02), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to requirements for licensure and certification.
