- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to promulgate a  
3 legislative rule relating to renewal of licensure or certification.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board.**

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 30, 2024, authorized under the  
2 authority of §30-38-9 of this code, modified by the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and  
3 Certification Board to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and  
4 refiled in the State Register on October 7, 2024, relating to the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing  
5 and Certification Board (renewal of licensure or certification, [190 CSR 03](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to renewal of licensure or certification.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
