- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Real Estate Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- 3 consideration of prior criminal convictions in initial license eligibility determination.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Real Estate Commission.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 9, 2024, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-1-24 of this code, relating to the Real Estate Commission (consideration of prior
- 3 criminal convictions in initial license eligibility determination, <u>174 CSR 07</u>), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Real Estate Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to consideration of prior criminal convictions in initial license eligibility determination.
