1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 requirements for registration and licensure and conduct constituting professional
 4 misconduct.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO

PROMULGATE

LEGISLATIVE

RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Registered Nurses.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 23, 2024, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-7-4 of this code, relating to the Board of Registered Nurses (requirements for
 3 registration and licensure and conduct constituting professional misconduct, [19 CSR 03](#)), is
 4 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to requirements for registration and licensure and conduct constituting professional misconduct.
