1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 authorizing the Board of Respiratory Care to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
3 consideration of prior criminal convictions in initial licensure determinations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO

PROMULGATE

RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Respiratory Care.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on February 27, 2024, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-1-23 of this code, modified by the Board of Respiratory Care to meet the
3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
4 September 9, 2024, relating to the Board of Respiratory Care (consideration of prior criminal
5 convictions in initial licensure determinations, [30 CSR 10](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Respiratory Care to promulgate a legislative rule relating to consideration of prior criminal convictions in initial licensure determinations.
