### **Senate Bill 411**

- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the Office Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative rule  
3 relating to the certification, recertification, and training of EMT-Miners and the certification  
4 of EMT-M instructors.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO  
PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-10-1. Office Miners' Health, Safety, and Training.**

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on November 7, 2024, authorized under the  
2 authority of §22A-10-3 of this code, relating to the Office Miners' Health, Safety, and Training (the  
3 certification, recertification, and training of EMT-Miners and the certification of EMT-M instructors,  
4 [56 CSR 22](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the certification, recertification, and training of EMT-Miners and the certification of EMT-M instructors.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
