A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding a new article,
designated §1-8-1, relating to restrictions on powers of state agencies and political
subdivisions; prohibiting state agencies and political subdivisions from restricting use,
purchase, or sale of motor vehicles based on energy or power source; defining terms; and
providing exceptions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 8. RESTRICTIONS ON POWERS OF STATE AGENCIES AND POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

§1-8-1. Restrictions of motor vehicles based on power source prohibited.

- (a) No state agency or political subdivision of this state may restrict the use, purchase, or
 sale of motor vehicles based on the energy source used to:
- 3 (1) Power the motor vehicle for propulsion; or
- 4 (2) Power other functions of the motor vehicle.
- 5 <u>(b) For purposes of this section:</u>
- 6 (1) "Motor vehicle" means a self-propelled device designed to transport persons or 7 property from one place to another and includes, but is not limited to, a "farm tractor" or "implement
- 8 of husbandry" as defined in §17A-1-1 of this code, but excludes "electric bicycles" as defined in
- 9 §17C-1-70 of this code;
- 10 (2) "State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution,

 11 agency, or other unit of state government; and
- 12 (3) "Use" refers to the use on a publicly maintained right-of-way that is open to the use of 13 the public for purposes of vehicular travel.
- (c) This section does not affect or invalidate any rule or policy established by a state
 agency or a political subdivision of this state related to the use, purchase, or sale of motor vehicles
 by that state agency or political subdivision.
